Abstract

needs, a generative psychological space (which allows individuals to experience positivity and

produce enduring transformative outcomes) is nurtured. This generative psychological space, in

turn, helps to build a capacity to respond proactively to the external environment and adapt well

to environmental jolts. The results lend support to our hypothesized model in which caring

among TMT members nurtures generativity, which in turn enhances strategic adaptability. In so

doing, we aim to further cultivate discussion on the micro-foundations of strategic management

in general and increase interest in the micro-relational foundations of strategic capabilities in

particular.
